

How are R.F. students doing in 20-1 from math 10c:

Analyzing the Data:

Clearly there is a strong correlation with the mark in 10 c and their final mark in 20-1 as shown by the line of best fit.

Marks 65 and above in 10 c seems to guarantee passing 20-1 but as you can see there are a very broad range of results in this area. Some students maintain their excellence level while some drop of substantially. Daily work habits ,accountability for their learning, and diligence play a huge factor in what happens.

Results of 60 to 70 in 10C present a real challenge to success in 20-1.

The common math course in 10c does prepare students for either stream 20-1 or 20-2 in terms of math concepts but it really depends on the standard of work habits that a students is prepared to invest in the course as to whether they will find success in the next level. It is also very important to research what course you will be required to have in the post secondary field you plan to go into. **It is better to have a strong mark the course required than a lower mark in a course that is not required.**
